Weare Board of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes
September 6, 2007

This posted meeting took place at 1:30 p.m. on the corner of East Street and Rte 114. The purpose was to meet with Bill Couture, Project Coordinator from Public Service of New Hampshire to discuss the placement of utility poles on the corner of East Street and Rte 114 beginning at the south side of the Town Library to the corner and from the corner to the first pole on the gazebo Town property.

There was concern that if the plan as has been shown to the Board was implemented the large maple tree on the corner of East Street and Rte 114 would have to be cut down or another alternative would be a pole with a push pole on Rte 114 on the west side of the gazebo.

Mr. Couture was asked if the pole now near the library could be moved across the street to the gazebo land. He indicated that it could, and the line could then go directly to the pole being placed on the corner of the Stone Building property. Electricity to the Stone Building would continue to go underground. Mr. Neville, contractor, would need to be apprised of this and work with Mr. Knapp to work this out.

A pole further down going south on Rte 114 would need a push pole on the Center Store property could have a guide wire. Mr. Couture and Chairman Clow would go over to the Center Store and discuss it with the Center Store owners.

The Board needs to contact the telephone company since their lines are on the telephone poles. A cable box is on the pole that is in the middle of the island on East Street, and since that pole is being removed Comcast should be notified as well.

This information will be brought to the full Board of Selectmen at their September 10, 2007 meeting for further discussion.

The meeting was over at 2:10 p.m.
